

Toilet Training Program Commitment Contract

- Try to start Friday or Saturday morning. It is best if you try not to go out much on this weekend in order to get a good, consistent start with your child.
- > Begin with Pull-ups or training underwear. Once you have started, please do not go back to diapers.
- If necessary, i.e. your child does not make it "dry" through the nights, line the bed with plastic, a towel and a sheet (a couple of layers so you can just throw it in the wash). The whole idea is to communicate to your child that it is no longer OK to be in diapers. That is why we ask you to stop the diaper usage now that potty training is beginning.
- For the car seat line with plastic or you can buy a car seat protector.
- It is helpful to take your child shopping for his/her underwear if he/she is excited about being able to do this so he/she will not want to wear diapers anymore. Please be sure the underwear is not too small or too big.
- Have your child change or at least help change, his/her own clothes if he/she has an accident. It helps him/her feel independent and secure that he/she did not do anything wrong and will go on trying accidents do happen.
- Have your child go potty <u>before</u> leaving home. This avoids accidents in your car and gives him/her a sense of success.
- Boys: As much as possible, please purchase uniform pants/shorts with elastic waistline.
- Please bring four (4) changes of clothes. Please include underclothes, a pair of shoes and a couple of pairs of socks in case of accidents. Soiled clothes will be put into a plastic bag with your child's name on it and placed in the restroom for you to pick up at the end of the day. Please check with Teachers daily for your child's needs. We cannot be responsible for soiled clothes left overnight or over weekends.
- It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to supply pull-ups, underwear, and wipes. In the event your child runs out of pull-ups, pants or panties, you will be charged \$3.00 per pair for a replacement.

Thank you for allowing us to assist your child with this important phase in his/her development! Your cooperation on the above points is a great help for your child's proper growth and adjustment.
