


FUNDRAISING TIPS FOR FEBRUARY

1) Keep your Family Goal in a visible place and let your child move the marker every time a donation is made! (*Reminder: Fundraising Commitment is \$250/family*)



Example:

- Print a race track and put dollar amounts on the different gray spots.
- Get a magnet and attach it to the bottom of a light toy car.
- Put the chart on the fridge and when you get to the dollar amount, let your child move the car!
- 2) Write a letter/e-mail about Little Flower and what Little Flower means to your family, include a picture of your child. At the end of the letter/e-mail ask for donations and school support. Include your address to send money. Send that email to everyone you know!!!!!
- 3) Facebook, Instagram, and Tweet about the Walk of Love! Ask your child to put on running gear and send it out to your family and friends asking them to support Little Flower, a school that is helping your child make steps in the right direction.
- 4) **Just ask!** Many people have a hard time putting words to asking others for a donation. The easiest thing to do is straight ask.

 - My child is participating in a walk to raise money for the school, can you please support her/him by making a donation?
